SITE INVESTIGATION WORKS

MARINERS ARE ADVISED THAT ON WEDNESDAY 15TH OCTOBER OR SHORTLY THEREAFTER FOR A PERIOD OF APPROXIMATELY 6 WEEKS, SITE INVESTIGATION WORKS WILL BE TAKING PLACE IN THE AREA TO THE NORTH NORTH WEST OF GLADSTONE LOCK IN THE AREA THAT IS DESIGNATED FOR THE SEAFORTH RIVER CONTAINER TERMINAL.

THE WORKS WILL BE TAKING PLACE FROM A JACK UP BARGE CALLED THE 'ARAN 90'. THE BARGE WILL BE MOVING LOCATIONS WITHIN ITS WORKING AREA AND SHOULD AT NO TIME HAMPER NAVIGATION.

THE BARGE WILL EXHIBIT THE LIGHTS AND SHAPES APPLICABLE TO A BARGE OF THIS CONSTRUCTION AND WILL BE FITTED WITH AN AUTOMATIC FOG SIGNAL OF ONE LONG BLAST.

IN THE EVENT OF EMERGENCY AND FOR COMMUNICATION THE 'ARAN 90' IS FITTED WITH MARINE BAND VHF AND WILL LISTEN ON CHANNEL 12.
